# Questions about infantile hemangioma

- 1 What **examinations and tests** will my baby need ?
- 2 What **should I watch out** for with my baby's infantile hemangioma
- 3 What happens to the hemangioma **over time if left untreated** ?
- 4 What are the possible **complications** ?





# Questions about the medication

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- ① How does the medication **work** ?
  - ② Is this medication **right for my baby** ?
  - ③ How **quickly can I expect** treatment with the medication to work ?
  - ④ What are the **side effects** associated with this medication ?
  - ⑤ How long will my baby **need to take** the medication ?
  - ⑥ How do I get my baby **started on the medication** ?
